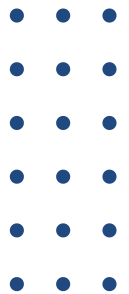

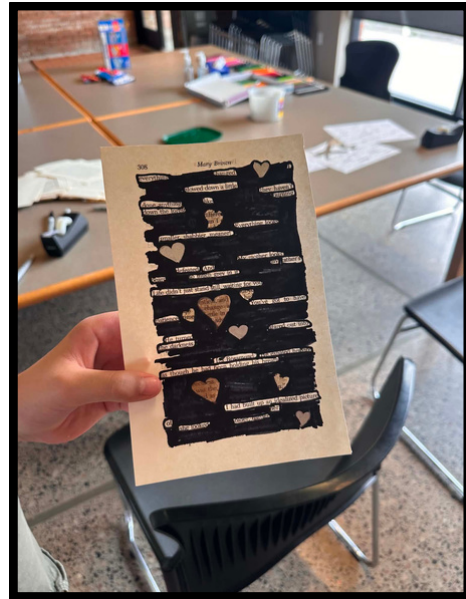

Digital Resources Spotlight: Peterson's College & Career Prep

Gale Presents: Peterson's Test and Career Prep is an online learning resource that offers a central hub for standardized test prep, college planning, career assessment, job searches, and more. Test prep resources help users prepare for a variety of standardized exams, including college entry exams like the SAT and ACT, and vocational exams in industries like law enforcement, journeyman, cosmetology, as well as U.S. citizenship. Students can find college planning tools, including a school search and a scholarship search. Job seekers can take advantage of career exploration tools including career assessments, advice, help creating resumés and cover letters, and a job search engine. Director's Report

At the end of July I met with Mike Dinwiddie to see White River Electric's new AV system in their meeting room, and he gave me the contact information for the company he worked with for the equipment. I met with them, VLCM, virtually to go over the ideas and needs for the Community Room. They have wonderful suggestions, and will be coming out on August 27th to see the room in person to further make a plan.

In collaboration with the Rec District, we will be placing an official Free Little Library at Paintbrush Park. I believe this will be a great way to spread awareness and exposure for the library out into the community, and may reach current non-library users. We will be able to advertise library programs on the box to further bring people back to the library. If it is successful, we will look into adding more around town.

Summer Reading was a great success this year! We had a 6% increase of participants that completed the program from last year, and an overall increase of participants that signed up and engaged. Library staff worked very hard on this program, and our increased numbers reflect that. Our next partnered blood drive with Vitalant has been scheduled for November 2nd. They have added additional time to this drive so that they will be able to accommodate more donors because of the fantastic response the first one received.
