

Colorado Libraries Collaborate (CLC) Policy

Adopted: 2/28/2024

The Meeker Regional Library District offers reciprocal borrowing privileges to non-MRLD residents who are cardholders of Colorado Libraries Collaborate (CLC) program participants.

Rules/Regulations:

- Acceptable forms of picture I.D.: driver's license, passport, school I.D., or any other government-issued document showing a photo and borrower's name.
- Acceptable forms for proof of address: driver's license, checkbook, car registration, pay stub (with address), mail with a current postmark, bill, mortgage or lease agreement, or any "official" document with borrower's name and current address.
- Proof of a current library card in a participating CLC library must be provided.
- MRLD may contact the home library of the borrower to determine good standing before issuing a CLC card.

CLC borrowers:

- It is the CLC borrower's responsibility to be in good standing at his/her home library. Cardholders not in good standing may not be eligible to borrow materials from the MRLD.
- CLC borrowers are responsible for understanding and abiding by the rules and policies of MRLD.
- CLC borrowers are responsible for all materials checked out on their cards.
- Any materials borrowed by a CLC borrower are subject to the MRLD loan policies and due dates.
- CLC borrowers are allowed access to subscription databases linked to library computers, but not library resources outside of the library (ebooks, eaudiobooks, streaming, etc.).
